





Nanaimo CDC Celebrates 50 Years in the Community



The Nanaimo Child Development Centre celebrated 50 years of opening doors on May 15th. You only have to walk through the doors at the NCDC to feel the love and caring, see the joy in the children's faces, to hear the laughter echo down the halls and to know how very special place it is. The NCDC is not just a building; it is a Centre for triumphs, big and small, a place for children and families to learn. Fifty years of serving our community is no small feat and we would like to acknowledge the difference the donors, local business support, dedicated volunteers and staff have made in the lives of so many children.


It was the 60's and the times they were 'a changing' – individuals in the community were

actively promoting public awareness that the children with special needs in Nanaimo needed better services. In 1967 a small group of dedicated individuals acted on this need. With the support of a number of community groups, all sharing the same vision of local services and programs for children with special needs, the Nanaimo Neurological and Cerebral Palsy Association (NNCPA) was formed. Since then the centre has grown leaps and bounds each year with new programs, services, equipment and families.

"I'm proud to say that the NCDC is celebrating its 50th year serving our community. Also, I think it's important to say that we have the distinct honour of being the oldest Child Development Centre in BC", says Michael Robinson, President of the NCDC Board of Directors. "Fifty is no small number! To picture the number of children and their families that have benefited from our services over the decades is very humbling. The centre and its staff are constantly working to open doors for children through new programs, specialized equipment and with new and innovative therapies. It is an inspiration for me to play a part in continuing this legacy."

The centre celebrated its 50th milestone with a commemorative carving by local artisan Mike Brown, unveiled at our May 15th open house. Our 50th Bear has been a popular visit spot for children ever since.

The NCDC looks forward to serving the Nanaimo and area families for the next 50 years.

How Funds Are Used

All donations made to the NCDC are tax deductible and go directly to programs and services that support children and families in our community.

Funds raised at the Silly Boat Regatta provide services to the communities from Ladysmith to Lantzville, including Protection & Gabriola Island as well as being the mid-north Island CDBC assessment site. The Centre has grown tremendously through the years, starting with just 7 clients in 1967 to providing 1,900 services to children & families last year. To date the centre has helped over 14,000 children.

- Support for families to maintain their integrity
- Support for communities to respond to the child care needs of all children

Supported Child Development also provides educational opportunities for childcare providers on a regular basis.

The Supported Child Development Program consults to inclusive child care programs for children from birth to twelve years of age who require additional supports.



The Nanaimo CDC rates in the top 3% CARF accredited facilities in the World ensuring practices are based on high standards of quality and accountability.

WE PROVIDE DIRECT SERVICES TO CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES IN SEVEN PROGRAM AREAS:

EARLY INTERVENTION

Typically provided in the client's home to support a familycentered model of service delivery, this program area emphasizes the importance of early identification and assessment of developmental needs. Specific services include early identification, developmental assessments, consultation with families, care providers, professionals and community members, intervention, client advocacy, education & training, and referral to other professionals and resources. The Centre includes professional staffing in specialty areas including Physiotherapy, Family Development, Speech & Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Infant Development.

CHILD & YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

The mandate of this program is to build family capacity and provide opportunities for clients with identified special needs (and their families) to increase their knowledge and skills in order to maximize their independence and community integration. Specific services provided include therapeutic and skill-based individual and group support sessions, education & training, and consultation with families and community members in a range of topics including safety, social skills, and behavioural supports.

SUPPORTED CHILD DEVELOPMENT

The mandate of this program is to coordinate inclusive child care for children from birth to 12 years of age who require extra supports. Specific services provided include consultation with staff, family members, preschools & daycares, and professionals, education & training, advocacy, referral to community resources, development of support guide including assessment and screening for 1:1 support, and contracting for extra staffing supports where needed.

SCHOOL AGE THERAPY

The mandate of this program is to provide services to school age children that assist in health maintenance, and provide education which increases the benefit of educational and community programs. Specific services provided include functional assessment, screening, consultation to School District support personnel, therapy intervention, advocacy, education. Professional staffing is provided by the Centre for Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy.

VICAN (VANCOUVER ISLAND CHILDREN'S ASSESSMENT NETWORK)

We provide Tier 3 assessment services for children from birth to 19 years of age with a query of Autism Spectrum Disorder, Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder, or Complex Child & Youth. Specific services provided include assessment/functional recommendations, referrals to other resources as needed, and a post-assessment family conference. Professional staffing available at the Centre include a Psychologist, Speech Language Pathologist, Occupational Therapist, and administrative support personnel.

PRESCHOOL

The NCDC Preschool provides a licensed, high quality, inclusive & developmentally appropriate preschool education for clients on a fee-for-service basis. Classroom and play areas are on-site at the Centre which provides 60 spaces annually. Classes are offered in morning and afternoon sessions with a choice of two or three days per week. Program starts the first week of September and completes the last week of June.

C.A.R.E. PROGRAM

Therapeutic lending library: equipment, DVD's, books and toys, internet access for families, parent education and community education, Seating Clinic and paediatric partnerships.

What does the Nanaimo, Child Development Centre Silly Boat Regatta mean to Amy Morris?


Spending a day at the beach has always been a favorite activity for her, but add to the sun and sand some silly costumes and handmade boats constructed on site....it becomes a family day of exceptional fun.

The Silly Boat Regatta has been offering up fun for Amy's and other Nanaimo families since 1984 and it is an import fundraising event that supports the many services the Child Development Centre provides to children and families in our community. Our family has been attending the event since she was a toddler just taking her first steps. Those steps did not happen for Amy until just before she was 2 years old and the Child Development Centre played a key role in those first steps and in the many that followed. Amy received her first at home therapy session from the Nanaimo Child Development Centre at age one and graduated from Preschool at the Centre when she was ready for Kindergarten. Low muscle tone, mobility and cognitive abilities were just a few things NCDC staff provided one on one and group therapy sessions to address.

The NCDC staff has an amazing hands-on approach to treatments and a great knowledge of motor skills

development. Their compassion and communication with children and their families is outstanding. You cannot build a strong, amazing structure without starting with a solid base. The NCDC was that base of support that contributed to the sky-is-the-limit person Amy is today.

Today, Amy excels both academically and athletically. She has just completed her first year on academic scholarship at Simon Fraser University. She is studying in the Bachelor of Science: Kinesiology program and is also a member of SFU's varsity track and field and cross country team. She has competed on Team British Columbia in cross country and was the 2016 BC Athletics Junior Female Road Runner of the Year.

Helping families find their way

The NCDC Family Resource Navigator

Finding our way around can be difficult without support... just think about how many of us use our phones or GPS instead of searching for the correct turn.

In the area of family and child development there is no GPS or easy way to get the information on the resources, supports, and programs in a one-stop-shop. Because of this, families may miss out on opportunities and programs they are unaware of, or even spend hours searching without finding the relevant information. This was identified as an ongoing challenge by staff and families, but with challenge, comes opportunity and the NCDC saw the opportunity to help.

In July 2015, with funding from Children's Health Foundation of Vancouver Island, RBC Foundation and Vancouver Foundation the NCDC introduced Family Resource Navigator. Kimberlee came onboard and has an extensive background in the industry and said she "looks forward to meeting and helping new families' everyday navigate the system".

How can the Family Resource Navigator help you? Well, this relatively new resource is not just for families who are clients at the NCDC but also for community individuals, groups, and other child development professionals. Our Family Resource Navigator can help:

- Provide you with information about community resources in the areas of financial, social, health, parenting, and special needs.
- Provide you with ways to access community resources

- Navigate systems such as health, social services, schools and other networks both locally and provincially
- Facilitate opportunities for community and parent networking, including partnering with community members to host our Families Supporting Families Peer to Peer Group, Family Knowledge Nights.





